

BOOKING AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Newton Cove Lodge must receive a deposit of 50% at the time of booking to secure your reservation. Deposits are valid only for the calendar year in which your trip is booked, and are non-refundable. The final payment of 50% is due 30 days (1 month) before the scheduled trip and is non-refundable. Reservations made 30 days prior to arrival require payment in full at the time of booking. Any trips that are paid in full as part of a discounted special are non-refundable.

Newton Cove Lodge will hold a requested date for 72 hours after which time if a deposit has not been paid the dates can be released.

We do understand that life happens to everyone and in the case of a medical emergency or immediate family death* your trip deposit can be transferred to another available date within one year from your reserved date. (*documentation required)

We only accept 24 guests at a time and have a short season, so a cancellation impacts us significantly. Therefore we have a strict cancellation policy: a refund will be issued ONLY if the cancelled trip can be filled with another EQUAL booking. There are no exceptions. A 15% administration fee will apply to all and any refunds.

Prior to your arrival a lot of the costs associated with your trip have already been incurred and other anglers turned down for your reserved spots. In order to protect trip payments, it is highly recommended that cancellation insurance is purchased; this is available at most travel agencies.

Because bookings are made so far in advance, there will be no reduction in rates or refunds for guests who voluntarily eliminate any of the services included in the booking rate, or who depart the lodge prior to the end of their scheduled stay. No refunds on early departures, missed fishing trips or fishing trips/lodging that you may cancel after arrival.

Newton Cove Lodge will not be responsible or liable for any loss, damage or injury to participants, personal property or for any cancellations or delays incurred as a result of weather, transportation or other conditions we have no control over. Newton Cove Lodge reserves the right to make changes for the safety and proper handling of clients and guests. We are always aware of safety; however, outdoor activities of this nature are not risk free.
